DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW

The Los Angeles County Department of Parks and Recreation (LA County Parks) manages 184 parks with over 518 sports amenities, operates a network of 6 regional parks, 20 community parks, 15 wildlife sanctuaries, 10 nature centers, 42 public swimming pools, more than 250 miles of multi-use trails for hiking, biking, and horseback riding, and the largest municipal golf system in the nation, consisting of 20 golf courses. LA County Parks local and community parks offer a wide variety of parks and amenities such as playgrounds, skateparks, gyms, recreation centers, athletic facilities, dog parks serving unincorporated areas.

The Department also maintains four botanical gardens and two performance venues: The Los Angeles County Arboretum and Botanic Garden, the South Coast Botanic Garden, Descanso Gardens, Virginia Robinson Gardens, Hollywood Bowl and John Anson Ford Amphitheatre providing County residents with valuable recreation and cultural and historic resources and experiences.

To advance its mission and further the health and wellness of unincorporated Los Angeles County communities, LA County Parks offers programming for children, youth, teens, adults and older adults. Examples of programs include summer camps, after-school programs, youth sports, Our SPOT Teen Centers, contract classes, arts and culture, older adults programming, lunch and snack nutrition programs for youth and families, aquatics and a core and community partnership agreement program.

Examples of activities include cultural classes and events, group walks, special interest classes, clubs, field trips and inter-generational experiences. Resources and referrals, case management, and social services are offered by community-based organizations and other County Departments. Service providers are co-located. Operates 52 weeks per year, closed on County observed holidays.

CORE PROGRAMS

LOCAL AND REGIONAL PARKS

Arcadia Park Bowling Greens

Arcadia County Park's historic lawn bowling greens, established in 1937, are a unique recreational feature within the Los Angeles County Park system. Originally developed during the park's WPA-era construction, the facility has grown into a rare four-green complex supporting both recreational and competitive lawn bowling. The greens are maintained year-round by Los Angeles County Parks and Recreation Grounds Maintenance staff and continue to serve as an important community asset and part of Arcadia County Park's longstanding recreational legacy

Community Cohesion Events and Cultural Experiences

The Department supports a wide variety of community cohesion events and cultural experiences throughout the year that celebrate culture, strengthen community connections, and create welcoming spaces for residents and families across LA County. Department-wide, 59 parks will host a total of eight major events and experiences, including four Community Cohesion events and four Cultural events. These longstanding programs are a hallmark of LA County Parks recreation programming, bringing communities together through seasonal celebrations, cultural traditions, educational experiences, entertainment, and family-friendly activities. Events and experiences include Trick or Treat Village, Harvest Festival, Holiday in the Park, Spring Jubilee, Hispanic Heritage Month, Lunar New Year, Black History Month, Parks at Sunset, Pride in the Park, and two signature cultural events: Juneteenth and Day of the Dead.

Natural Area Parks will also be hosting community cohesion events and cultural experiences including Pride month, Indigenous People's Day and Dia de los Muertos.

Eddie Heredia Boxing Club

The Eddie Heredia Boxing Club offers a variety of boxing classes geared to teach youth of all skill levels, from beginners stepping into the gym for the first time to advance, preparing to spar and compete at the local, regional, and national levels.

Our mission is to promote health, fitness, discipline, and personal growth while making a positive impact on every participant. Through the sport of boxing, youth develop confidence, respect, and the tools needed to succeed both inside and outside the ring.

Participants will learn:

- Fundamentals of Olympic-style boxing
- Amateur competition training
- Strength, conditioning, and fitness for overall health and weight management
- Health and nutritional awareness
- Good sportsmanship and teamwork
- Character development and self-esteem
- Self-control and anger management
- Discipline, focus, and social skills
- Self-defense techniques

Every Body Plays Drop-In After School Programs

Every Body Plays After-School Program is a free non-custodial program for youth ages 7 to 17 offered at 59 LA County Park locations. Supervised by trained Recreation staff, participants can enjoy homework help, sports and fitness, STEM projects, cultural experiences, enrichment classes, group games, events, field trips, and more while building confidence, teamwork, and social skills in a fun and welcoming environment. As part of the program expansion, sites introduced new tech labs in Fall 2025, giving youth opportunities to explore technology, digital learning, gaming, coding, creative projects, and hands-on tech experiences. The program operates Monday through Friday from September 1, 2026 through May 21, 2027, from 2:30 PM to 6:00 PM, with earlier start times on early release days. Parks observe County holidays, special County training days, and are closed during winter and spring breaks

Every Body Plays Drop-in Summer Adventures

Every Body Plays Summer Adventures is a free non-custodial summer program offered at LA County Parks for youth ages 7 to 17. The program provides a safe and welcoming environment led by caring, trained park staff who serve as mentors and activity leaders. Participants can enjoy daily adventures including sports, fitness, arts and crafts, ESTEAM projects, group games, story time, and much more, with each day focused on fun, learning, and connection. The program will run from June 15, 2026 through August 7, 2027 at 37 locations. Every Body Plays Summer Adventures operates Monday through Friday from 11:00 AM to 5:30 PM. Free lunch is available at select locations from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM, while snacks are served daily at every site from 3:00 PM to 4:00

Every Body Plays Sports for All - provide clinics at various locations where youth can have fun, stay active, and learn basic skills in soccer, flag football, volleyball, basketball, baseball/softball, basketball, and other sports. An 8-10 week seasonal sport league is offered at 59 locations across LA County. Volunteers are needed to coach and to be team parents. Pre-registration and try-outs are required.

Our SPOT Teen Centers

Our SPOT (Social Places and Opportunities for Teens) Teen centers are located throughout LA County's Parks and provides FREE daily after-school activities Monday through Friday from 3:00 pm to 9:00 pm for youth ages 12 through 17. The program supports positive youth development by exposing teens to caring mentors, social justice projects, leadership and artists experiences, early career exploration, substance abuse prevention, sports and physical fitness, and other opportunities meaningful to youth. Teens participate in park advisory groups and contribute to the planning of field trips, events and social action projects.

Well-Being Lounges are currently offered at 14 of the 16 Our SPOT Teen Centers and provide year-round wellness programming designed specifically for teens. Programming focuses on supporting

mental, emotional, and physical well-being through activities such as mindfulness, fitness, creative expression, workshops, and other wellness-centered experiences.

Held on Fridays in June, July, and August, a total of fifteen camping events will take place at Frank G. Bonelli Regional Park, Castaic Lake State Recreation Area, Kenneth Hahn State Recreation Area, Santa Fe Dam Recreation Area, and Whittier Narrows Recreation Area. The program provides an affordable camping opportunity for families. Each site offering basic amenities such as restrooms, potable water, barbecues, shaded grassy areas, and designated RV camping zones. Admission fees apply to adults and children over the age of 13.

LA County Parks partners with community-based organizations to expand youth access to programming like youth sports, science, technology, engineering, arts, mathematics (STEAM) activities, environmental education, arts and culture, and community service. The Core and Community Partnership Program offers rentals of LA County Parks' facilities to qualified community organizations for no facility use fee or reduced facility use fee, depending on the program or service provided. The use of LA County Parks' facilities by community organizations expands park programming, provides benefits to the public and increases access to park facilities. Through these agreements, LA County Parks forges collaborative partnerships with committed community-based organizations and program providers. Eligible organizations can apply to become a Core Program Partner or a Community Program Partner, depending on the program or service provided, the type of direct benefits provided to LA County Parks, and the scope of partner responsibilities assumed by the organization.

- Partner Responsibilities (*Core, all four required; and Community, 2 required*)
 - Participate in an annual review meeting
 - Share annual financial records
 - Cross-promote DPR in social media, website, and other promotional channels as a partner
 - Feature DPR and Supervisorial District in program or events and in all related printed and digital promotional materials
